

A bitterly cold day didn't deter 73 participants, but it did limit the species count to 36 - the lowest since 1993. A further four species were recorded during the count period (December 15 - January 5). With COVID-19 still prevalent, most teams went out in convoy or individually.

Some of the most common species were present in unusually small numbers. Black-capped Chickadee count (456) was the lowest since 1997. Canada Goose was largely absent from the river. Their numbers were less than 10% of what is seen in an average year. Although Rock Pigeon were still abundant at 924, that was the lowest count since 1976. Red-breasted Nuthatch count (49) was the lowest since 1994.

Ron Jensen's count for Black-billed Magpie was easily the most surprising species count of the day. Over several hours in his sector he recorded only six magpies, but at the end of the day, in the hour or so before sunset he saw 768 magpies fly into the dog park at Sutherland Beach to roost for the night. The magpie count in all other sectors combined was 357. After some discussion about how many counts should be eliminated as probable duplicates, it was decided to use the count at the roost site as a proxy for the entire city and add the counts for the five rural sectors in the southern half of the circle, for a total of 871.

The counts for Common Redpoll (1052) and Snow Bunting (350) were triple and double their 20-year averages. The Clark's Crossing and Pike lake counts were also high for these two species confirming a major irruption this year.

Species added during the count period (December 15 - January 5) were Northern Hawk Owl, Northern Saw-whet Owl, Gyrfalcon and Townsend's Solitaire.

Thank you to all participants in the count. The Saskatoon Christmas count has been conducted continuously since 1955. Please join us next year for the 68th annual count.
