

# Saskatoon Nature Society "Kids in Nature" Grant Program 2026 Information and Instructions

Deadline for applications is January 15, 2026

The Saskatoon Nature Society (SNS), through its "Kids in Nature" grant program, aims to strengthen existing programs and encourage new initiatives that connect youth in the Saskatoon area with nature. Eligible institutions with such programs are invited to apply for financial support. The total funding available is approximately \$2000.00. This amount may go to one applicant or may be divided among several applicants in varying amounts.

# Who is eligible to apply?

We accept proposals from educational institutions including primary or secondary schools, community associations, First Nations and Métis, and registered charities in the Saskatoon area. If you would like to discuss submitting a project but feel that you don't meet this criterion, please contact the Saskatoon Nature Society by e-mail at the address below.

### What types of projects are eligible?

The project must target children or youth up to and including 18 years of age. Funds can be used for a new project or an existing ongoing project. Priority will be given to projects with a focus on local natural history. Please note that gardening projects which do not focus on local natural history will not be considered.

### How do I apply?

Complete the form below and e-mail it to the address indicated below by the deadline for applications: <u>January 15, 2026</u>. The outcome of funding decisions will be communicated to all applicants by March 31, 2026.

## **Additional important information**

- Submitting a proposal is not a guarantee that a project will be funded.
- Only one proposal per institution will be accepted. If more than one is submitted, only the first one received will be reviewed.
- If you have previously received an SNS Kids in Nature grant, you must have previously submitted a report on how those funds were used and the learning outcomes and impact on students.
- All proposals will be assessed by an SNS committee.
